There are so many ways to implement these activities... whole group, small group, homework or even in literacy centers.



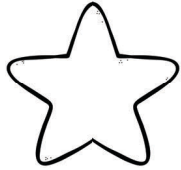
How to use this pack

The format stays the same so students know what is expected!

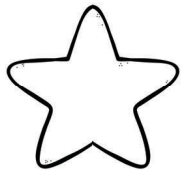
The sentence structure and vocabulary starts very simple and increases in difficulty throughout the school year.

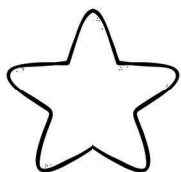
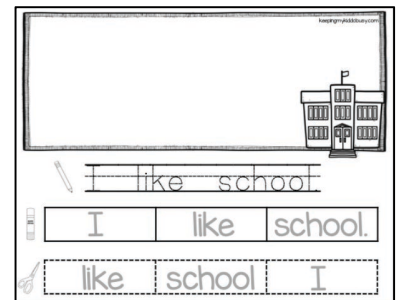


Use whole group or in a literacy center.
Students can read their book, trace the sentences, color the pictures, and answer the comprehension page at the back.



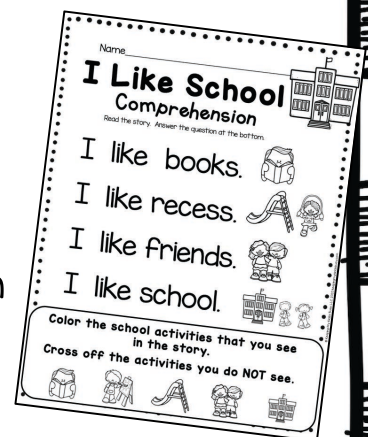
CUT & PASTE SENTENCES

Students read the sentence and trace the words. Then they cut and paste the words to match and build the sentence correctly. Finally, students illustrate a picture to match! Flip the paper over and they write the sentence on their own two times.



COMPREHENSION

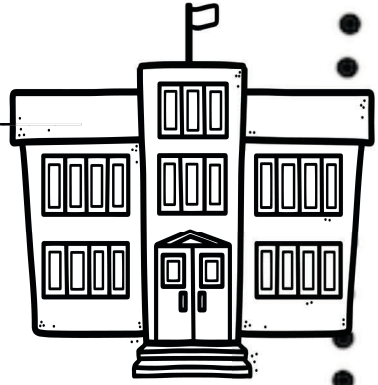
Use whole group or in small groups.
I read the passage, then we read it chorally together and finally students practice reading the passage on their own (or with a buddy.) We practice touching each word with our "magic reading finger" as we read. Then we read and answer the questions together.
